Just a reminder that all After School Clubs finish at 4.15pm, except Cooking which finishes at 4.30pm.



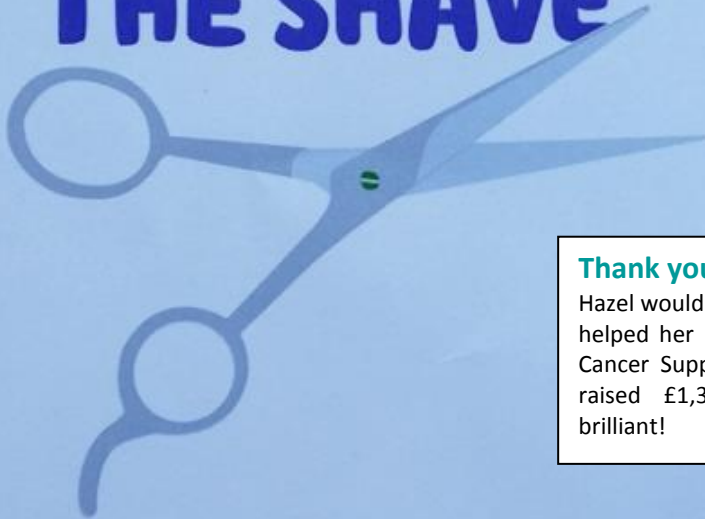
