Dear Parents / Carers

## **Key Stage 2 (Yrs 3-6) After School Clubs Autumn 2020**

As you will know from our previous correspondence, at the moment all our After School Clubs are running for Key Stage 2 children only. We have now finalised the details for this term's clubs, which **commence the week of Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September**. Full details can be found in the table overleaf.

Please complete the form on the reverse of this letter to indicate which clubs your child would like to attend by **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September**. Forms should be returned by your child to their class teacher. We will let you know by email on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September if your child **HAS NOT** been able to join all the clubs requested. If you do not hear from us, they will be signed up for the clubs as indicated on your form.

We have decided to allocate full funding for our Key Stage 2 after school sport and extra-curricular provision over this term. This will result in all after school clubs for Key Stage 2 being fully subsidised so there will be no cost to parents if they wish their child/ren to take part.

We will be using money the school receives in the form of PE and Sport Premium, which is a ring-fenced grant for English primary schools to provide additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE, sport and physical activity. In July, the Department for Education confirmed that any PE and Sport Premium funding from the academic year 2019-20 that schools were unable to use as a result of the coronavirus pandemic can be brought forward to use in the next academic year. We felt this would be the best use for this surplus funding during these challenging times and it means we are able to offer a broad range of extra-curricular opportunities.

At Thurton C of E Primary School, we strongly believe children should have the chance to have fun participating in sporting and extra-curricular activities, as this is beneficial to their physical and mental development.

If successful, we will repeat this again in the Spring term for children in Key Stage 1.

**Places for clubs will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis so please return your form as soon as possible.** There is a maximum of 20 spaces in each club, except Cooking Club which will have a maximum of 5. If there are any remaining spaces, these will be detailed in our Newsletter. Please could we ask that you check the Newsletter for any cancellations / changes to clubs throughout the term.

All clubs will operate in line with COVID-19-secure guidance. Should there be any changes to this guidance we will update you accordingly.

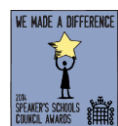

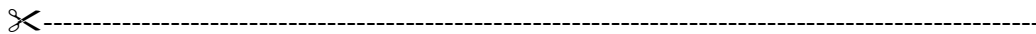
