We have organised a trip to Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse to support our learning about World War 2. The day will include a number of activities focused on the 'Home Front'. We will spend the day with the Gressenhall Education Staff, who will be dressed and acting in role throughout the day. We will take part in a number of organised activities, including being inside an actual WW2 Anderson shelter.

To fully engage with these activities we will be going in role ourselves and dressing the part. Please see attached sheet of ideas for costumes. Parts of the day will be spent outdoors so a coat will be required – please note that this does not have to be an authentic WW2 coat!!

Also attached are some ideas for making an authentic WW2 rationed packed lunch. Please help us to get into the spirit of WW2 by sticking to these guidelines as much as you can!

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at approximately 9am, therefore we are asking children to arrive promptly at school at 8.40am. We will be back for in time for the end of the school day.
