Dear Parents,

We hope you are all keeping well. Earlier today, parents of children in Year 6, Year 1 and Reception received some [information in regard to planning for the opening of school](#) to their children from 1st June following the Prime Minister's announcement on 10th May.

Should this go ahead, it will have implications on maintaining the same level of provision for home learning that teachers have set over the recent weeks. The main year groups that will be affected will be Year 2 and Year 5, as well as any children in the year groups which are eligible to return but do not. In order to continue to provide a level of home learning for these children, we are planning to reduce the school week to 4.5 days to enable teaching staff to have the capacity to continue to provide some form of remote learning for these children. Home learning for children in Year 3 and Year 4 should not be affected and will continue in the same way.

In conjunction with preparing the school for wider opening, we are also planning our provision for children of critical workers for the second half of the Summer Term.

If you are a critical worker and you find that you need your child to attend school due to your work commitments, please email office@thurton.norfolk.sch.uk or phone the school to let us know when you require provision.

In an emergency, please could we ask that you contact us by no later than 3:00pm on the day before.

If we are able to open to a wider range of pupils in June, children of key workers who are not in the eligible year groups will be grouped together in the Green room following the safety guidance outlined by the Department for Education.
