Dear Parents/Carers

Swimming Lessons – Hobart High School

The school has an obligation to ensure that children in Key Stage 2 can swim 25m before they finish primary school. We have arranged for the children in Year 3/4 to attend swimming lessons at Hobart High School after Christmas on a Tuesday afternoon. This is planned to be every Tuesday between 8th January and 2nd April, however, there may be dates within this that have to be cancelled due to circumstances that arise later in the year.

The children will need their swimming kit (one-piece suit for girls, close-fitting short or trunks for boys) on these dates. Please note that all children must wear a swimming hat whilst in the water, and **all earrings will need to be removed before coming to school** on a Tuesday.

We will be travelling to and from Hobart by coach. We will be leaving school just prior to the end of lunchtime, but will ensure the children eat their lunch in good time to leave. We will be returning to school at around 2.30pm.

Please could you complete the attached consent form and return it to school by **Tuesday 11th December 2018**. If your child is in Year 3 we would be grateful if you could also complete the very short questionnaire below.

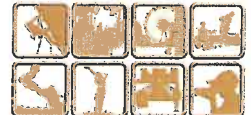
