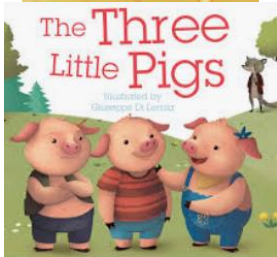
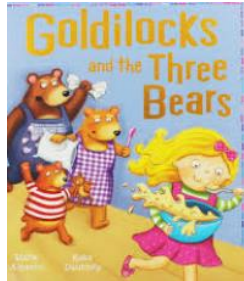




Once upon a time

In Literacy/ CL we are going to:

- Write questions to ask the big bad wolf.
- Complete a character description using adjectives.
- Goldilocks wanted posters.
- Re-tell a range of different traditional tales through small world and role play.
- Create a fact poster about different types of homes.
- Write party invitations to traditional tale characters.

In Maths we are going to:

- Count, sort and order numbers to 10 / 20
- Add and subtract within 20
- Find number pairs to 10
- Order lengths and heights
- Identify 2D and 3D shapes
- Continue repeating patterns using shapes
- Using positional language

In Science/ UW we are going to:

- Find out about Everyday Materials – describing them, thinking about their uses and comparing them – linked to The Three Little Pigs houses.
- Plant bulbs outside to observe how they grow later in the school year.

In RE we are going to:

- Learning about the Christmas story

In Computing we are going to:

- Create Three Little Pig pictures using paint.
- Operate simple equipment e.g. listening to audio books on the CD player.
- Learning to programme bee-bots & correct their routes – Little Red Riding Hood map

In History/Geography we are going to:

- Learn about types of homes around the UK. – Look at homes in Thurton first then other areas.

In Art & Design / EAD we are going to:

- Create Little Red Riding Hood collage pictures
- Listen to a range of traditional tale music, play tuned / un-tuned instruments musically to join in with a song.



In PSED we are going to:

- Learn about working as a team – taking in turns, working together to create things.

- Multi-skills
