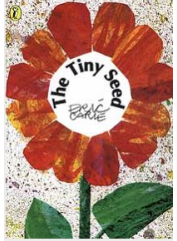
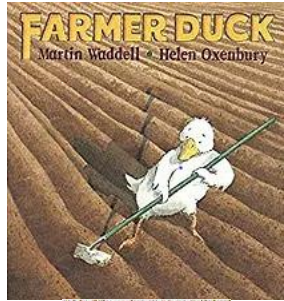


How does your garden grow?
